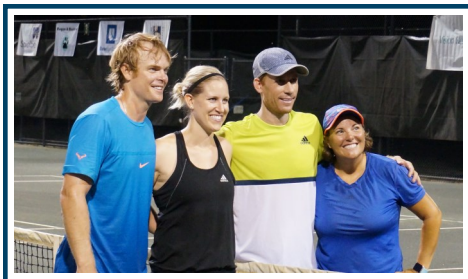

Entry Deadline:

All entries and fees are due by July 28. Tournament is limited to 60 teams.

Tournament Entry Fee:

\$100 per team includes event t-shirt, breakfast, lunch, and player social on Saturday for each team member. Tournament entry fee does not include tickets to the Friday night Patron Party. Patron Party tickets may be purchased separately at a cost of \$40 each or as a package with registration for a cost of \$160 per team.

Eligibility:

The combined ratings of each team member will determine the team's event (i.e. a team consisting of a 3.5 player and a 4.0 player would compete in the 8.0 event). NTRP rating is not required to play. The tournament committee reserves the right to place a team in a higher division if they have entered in a level too low, and to accept or reject any entry.

Draws will be posted Thursday, August 3 on the PBNC website at <http://www.pbnc.org> and also at the MacGregor Downs Tennis Shop. Players are expected to play when scheduled and should plan to arrive for check-in at least 30 minutes prior to their first match.
