2nd grade and up	Sloan Letters

▶ DETERMINE PRACTICE LINE, PASSING LINE AND REFERRAL CRITERIA: (BASED ON AGE)

Age	Passing	Refer If
4	20/40	20/50 or worse
5 and up	20/32	20/40 or worse

► CHECK FOR A TWO-LINE DIFFERENCE:

Refer children with a visual acuity difference of two or more lines between eyes.

Chart	Refer If:	
Lea	20/20 in one eye	20/32 or worse in the other eye
Symbols	20/25 in one eye	20/40 or worse in the other eye
Sloan	20/20 in one eye	20/32 or worse in the other eye

▶ REFER A CHILD FOR ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- 1. The child demonstrates one of the observable signs of vision problems.
- 2. The child has a failing acuity score in either eye.
- 3. The child has a two-line difference in visual acuity between the two eyes.
